

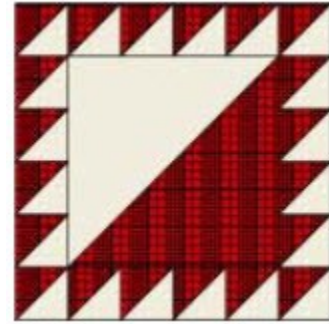
# Lady of the Lake

Finished Size 12" x 12"

Intermediate Level

Lady of the Lake is made with two colors and 2 sizes of squares. It is shown here in red and ivory.



## Cutting: Both colors are cut the same way, same number of pieces.

### Ivory

- 1 square -  $8 \frac{7}{8}$ " x  $8 \frac{7}{8}$ ", cut diagonally to make 2 half-square triangles (only 1 triangle needed for square). This is Piece 1A.
- 10 squares -  $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2 \frac{7}{8}$ "

### Red

- 1 square -  $8 \frac{7}{8}$ " x  $8 \frac{7}{8}$ ", cut diagonally to make 2 half-square triangles (only 1 triangle needed for square). Piece 2A
- 10 squares -  $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2 \frac{7}{8}$ "

## Piecing the Block:

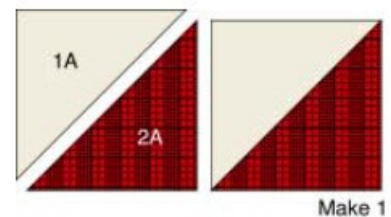
### Step 1. 20 Half Square Triangles:

On the wrong side of ivory fabric, draw diagonal line with the marking tool of your choice. Match a red and an ivory square together and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Press open to make pieced squares (Diagram I). Make 20.



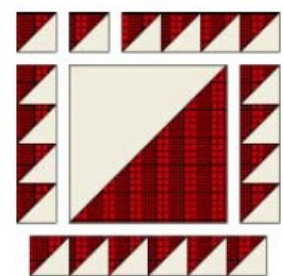

**Step 2.** Make one pieced-square center unit using the  $8 \frac{7}{8}$  inch squares, 1A and 2A.



## Assembly:

Referring to Assembly Diagram, sew the units together to make the block.
