BLOCK NUMBER 4 - Bear Paw

- These directions are for making a 12-inch square finished block.
- Use 1/4 inch seams throughout.
- You need three colors. One is a contrast fabric at center of the block.

The illustration shows the layout and the finished block.

STEP 1 Cutting:

From background fabric cut:

- 4 2 1/4 inch squares
- 8 2 ³/₄ inch squares
- 4 2 x 5 ¾ inch rectangles

From the color desired for paws, cut:


- 8 2 3/4 inch squares
- 4 4 inch squares


From the color to be used in the center, cut:

1 - 2 inch square

STEP 2: Make half-square triangle square using the $2 \frac{3}{4}$ inch squares as shown to the right. Iron them open and trim if needed to $2 \frac{1}{4}$ inch square. There will be 16 after cutting in half. Iron seam to darker color.







STEP 3: Join the pieces together as shown to complete the block.
