## BLOCK NUMBER 4 - Bear Paw

- These directions are for making a 12 -inch square finished block.
- Use $1 / 4$ inch seams throughout.
- You need three colors. One is a contrast fabric at center of the block.

The illustration shows the layout and the finished block.

## STEP 1 Cutting:

From background fabric cut:
4-2 $1 / 4$ inch squares
8-2 $3 / 4$ inch squares
4-2 x $53 / 4$ inch rectangles


From the color desired for paws, cut:
8-2 $3 / 4$ inch squares
4-4 inch squares

From the color to be used in the center, cut:
1-2 inch square

STEP 2: Make half-square triangle square using the $23 / 4$ inch squares as shown to the right. Iron them open and trim if needed to $2 \frac{1}{4}$ inch square. There will be 16 after cutting in half. Iron seam to darker color.
