## **Cutting Instructions**

(cut in order listed)

 $\square$  = cut in half diagonally White-on-white print

8 squares 25%" x 25%" Black print

6 squares 25/8" x 25/8"

6 squares 15%" x 15%" Red print

2 squares 25/8" x 25/8"

2 squares 15/8" x 15/8"

Red solid

6 squares 11/2" x 11/2" Light green print

6 squares 11/2" x 11/2" Tan print


8 rectangles 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

8 squares 11/2" x 11/2" 4 squares 37/8" x 37/8" □

## **Bow Tie Wreath**

## Sew

1 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of black print 15%" square. Referring to Diagram I, place marked square on white-on-white 25%" square, right sides together, aligning raw edges. Stitch on drawn line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Open and press to make pieced square. Make 6. In same manner make 2 red print/white pieced squares.



2 Stitch together 6 black print/white pieced squares, 2 red print/white pieced squares, 6 black print 25%" squares and 2 red print 25%" squares to make block center (Diagram II).




3 Referring to **Diagram III**, sew together 2 tan print 11/2" x 21/2" rectangles, 2 tan print 11/2" squares, 3 red solid 11/2" squares and 2 tan print 31/8" half-square triangles to make red/tan corner unit. Make 2. In similar manner, make 2 light green/tan corner units.



4 Join block center, 2 red/tan corner units and 2 green/tan corner units to make block (Diagram IV).
