# Lady of the Lake

Lady of the Lake is made with two colors and 2 sizes of squares. It is shown here in red and ivory.



# Cutting: Both colors are cut the same way, same number of pieces.

### **Ivory**

- 1 square 8 7/8" x 8 7/8", cut diagonally to make 2 half-square triangles (only 1 triangle needed for square). This is Piece 1A.
- 10 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

#### Red

- 1 square 8 7/8" x 8 7/8", cut diagonally to make 2 half-square triangles (only 1 triangle needed for square). Piece 2A
- 10 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

### **Piecing the Block:**

### **Step 1. 20 Half Square Triangles:**


On the wrong side of ivory fabric, draw diagonal line with the marking tool of your choice. Match a red and an ivory square together and sew 1/4" seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Press open to make pieced squares (Diagram I). Make 20.

**Step 2.** Make one pieced-square center unit using the 8 7/8 inch squares, 1A and 2A.





# **Assembly:**

Referring to Assembly Diagram, sew the units together to make the block.
