## Lady of the Lake

Intermediate Level
Lady of the Lake is made with two colors and 2 sizes of squares. It is shown here in red and ivory.


## Cutting: Both colors are cut the same way, same number of pieces.

Ivory

- 1 square - $87 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x $87 / 8^{\prime \prime}$, cut diagonally to make 2 half-square triangles (only 1 triangle needed for square). This is Piece 1A.
- 10 squares - $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$

Red

- 1 square - $87 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 87 / 8^{\prime \prime}$, cut diagonally to make 2 half-square triangles (only 1 triangle needed for square). Piece 2A
- 10 squares - $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x 2 7/8"


## Piecing the Block:

Step 1. 20 Half Square Triangles:
On the wrong side of ivory fabric, draw diagonal line with the marking tool of your choice. Match a red and an ivory square together and sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Press open to make pieced squares (Diagram I). Make 20.

Step 2. Make one pieced-square center unit using the 8 7/8 inch squares, 1A and 2A.
